The names shown on the seating list are merely for identification purposes in arranging the three groups in alphabetical order and in no way attempt to show names as they will appear on diplomas or will be called at commencement exercises.

FOR PRACTICE:

Time: 4:00 P. H., May 23 and 26. Assemble in designated seats in auditorium so that you will be arranged in alphabetical order. For your seat assignment and line-up arrangements, check the senior bulletin board in the front hall, or on each door to the auditorium at practice time.

It is <u>very important</u> that you plan to be at <u>both</u> practice sessions and that you be on time. The success of your two graduation exercises depends on your cooperation in participating in these practice sessions.

PROCEDURE FOR BACCALAUREATE:

Assemble between 1:30 and 1:45 P. M.--but no later than 1:45 P. M.--Sunday, May 25; it at Irving High School. Take your place in line immediately upon arrival and remain in order. DO NOT CHEM GUM, PLIASE.

Group 1: Line up in H hall beginning at Room H 119 and extending into J hall. Group 2: Line up in A hall beginning at Room A 103 and extending down A hall. Croup 3: Line up in D hall beginning at Room D 118 and extending into M hall.

Seniors enter auditorium with processional music, take places, and remain standing until after the invocation. (Do not leave any vacant seats.) Senior choir members take their places with the choir on stage and remain standing also. After the invocation, Mr. Moore will motion for the seniors to be seated.

Boys remove hats during invocation and benediction, then replace.

After the sermon, at the signal from a minister, seniors and audience rise and remain standing for the benediction and the singing of "The Lord Bless You and Keep You."

With the beginning of the music for the recessional, choir members leave the stage, join the same group with which they entered, and ushers lead out.

IMPORTANT: As you leave the auditorium, please do not break line in the front hall but continue marching in line following the ushers until they stop. This is neccessary so that the entire senior class may march smoothly out of the auditorium.

GIRLS be sure to try on your gown and fit the collar and pin or baste it securely before coming to baccalaureate. These collars will not stay securely placed unless attached. Personal items such as purses, etc., may be left in Room Kill which will be locked. Please pick up these items promptly after the program.

PROCEDURE FOR COMMENCEMENT:

Assemble between 7:30 and 7:45 P.M.—but no later than 7:45 P.M.—Tuesday, May 27, at the Dallas Municipal Auditorium. Take your place in line immediately upon arrival and remain in order. DO NOT CHEW GUM, PLEASE. All groups enter the door at the rear of the auditorium—between signs 5 and 8 on the parking lot—and form three lines (in the same groupings) in the area designated by signs posted in the hall when you enter.

After you are in line, you will be given a card with your name on it. KMEP THIS CARD, without mutilating, and hand it to Wrs. Hines or Mrs. Smith who will use it to call your name as you are presented your diploma cover. (Your diploma will be given to you when you turn in your cap and gown.) If you find we have spelled your name incorrectly on the card, one of your faculty supervisors will have blank cards and will print you a new card. If a card has not been provided for you, see Mrs. Walker or Mrs. Hostad.

Seniors enter with processional music, take places, and remain standing until after the invocation. (Do not leave any seats vacant.) Be seated immediately following the invocation. (Boys remove hats during invocation and benediction, then replace.)

ofr. Parr will introduce the honor graduates, after which Mr. Farr will present the class to Mr. Hanes who will speak briefly. Either Mr. Hanes or Dr. Bates will ask the class to come forward. From this time on, watch the two ushers for your group very closely. They will signal when for you to rise, march and be seated. After you receive your diploma cover and have returned to your place, remain standing until your entire row has returned and then the row be seated together at the signal from your usher.

After presentation of all diploma covers and all semiors have returned to their seats, Mr. Parr will ask the class to rise; he will then direct the class in moving tassels from right to left.

At a signal from Ar. Farr, the organist will play introductory notes for the alma mater; then, with the second playing, senior class only will sing the alma mater. All begin singing promptly, as only seniors will be singing. Cheer leaders and choir members please take the initiative in leading the singing.

(Boys keep hats on during the singing of the alma mater.)

Remain standing after singing of alma mater. The organist will begin playing the recessional. Wait for honor graduates to leave the stage and take their places at the beginning of Croup 1. Ushers will lead out.

<u>LIPORTANT</u>: As you leave the auditorium, please do not break line at the front door, but continue marching in line following the ushers, returning the same way you entered until you arrive at the designated table to get your diploma.

Rest rooms near the rear entrance from the parking lot will be designated for boys and girls. Personal items may be left in these rest rooms which will be locked. We cannot be responsible for personal items left in any other place.

Will you also please ask your parents' cooperation in not applauding for individual seniors, but wait until after all seniors have been recognized, and then really applaud.
